

# RPF Constable Eligibility Criteria

All aspiring candidates who are waiting to apply for the RPF Constable post for 2023 must be aware of a few things before applying for the recruitment. The eligibility criteria is a factor which plays a crucial role in determining whether the candidate is eligible or not for attending the examination. Let's take a look at the required eligibility criteria in detail as given below.

## RPF Constable Eligibility - Nationality

A Candidate should be an Indian Citizen.

## RPF Constable Eligibility - Age Limit

The age limit of candidates is a minimum of 18 years and a maximum of 25 years. The age of candidates will be calculated as of 1st July 2022 based on the age calculation criteria mentioned in the previous notification.

Minimum age: 18 years

Maximum age: 25 years

Candidates have to provide the date of birth as mentioned in their class 10 certificate.

## RPF Constable Eligibility - Educational Qualification

The RPF Eligibility educational qualification of candidates to apply for the Constable post should be of class 10. Candidates who have not received their class 10 certificates will not be considered eligible. (As per 2018 eligibility criteria)

The certificate produced by the candidates must be of a recognized board.

## RPF Sub Inspector Eligibility Criteria

We have seen the eligibility criteria of the constable post. Now, let's take a look at the required eligibility criteria for the post of RPF Sub Inspector. Candidates should always keep in mind that if none of the criteria as mentioned below is met by the candidates they will be disqualified and not eligible for the post. Candidates should be careful while applying for the examination making sure that they are eligible and qualified.

## RPF SI Eligibility - Nationality

Candidates need to be citizens of India.

## RPF SI Eligibility - Age Limit

The age limit of candidates should be a minimum of 20 and a maximum of 25 years. The age of all candidates will be calculated as of 1st July 2022 based on the data mentioned in the previous notification.

Minimum age: 18 years

Maximum age: 25 years

## RPF SI Eligibility - Educational Qualification

The RPF Eligibility educational qualification of all candidates applying for the RPF Sub Inspector post should be graduation level. Candidates who have not received their final certificates will not be considered eligible. (As per 2018 eligibility criteria)

The certificate produced by the candidates should be from a recognized university.

## Age Relaxations:

There will be age relaxation for all the candidates who are applying for RPF Constable and Sub Inspector posts:

Central Government Employees with minimum 3 years regular service	UR- 5 Years OBC NCL- 8 Years SC/ST- 10 Years

Widows/Divorced Women	UR- 2 Years

## RPF Eligibility Physical Measurement for Constable and Sub Inspector

The RPF physical measurement test, which will be the second stage of the selection process in the RPF recruitment, is the same for both Constable and Sub Inspector posts. In order to reach this stage, candidates need to clear stage one which will be the online-based objective type examination.
