

# CRPF Constable GD Eligibility Criteria

Aspirants must fulfil all the CRPF Constable GD Eligibility Criteria before applying for the post. If they fail to satisfy any of the CRPF GD Constable eligibility criteria, then it will lead to disqualification of their candidature. Here is the major overview of the CRPF Constable GD age limit and eligibility criteria shared below for the ease of the candidates.

## CRPF Constable GD Age Limit

Aspirants must analyse the official notification PDF to know the CRPF Constable age limit specified by the officials. The crucial date for determining the CRPF Constable GD age limit shall be as specified by the Staff Selection Commission. The minimum age limit should be 18 years, whereas the maximum age limit shall be 23 years when applying for the [CRPF Constable Recruitment](#). Here is the CRPF GD Constable Age Limit shared below.

Maximum Age Limit	23 years

## CRPF Constable GD Age Limit Relaxation

There shall be a relaxation on the upper age limit for reserved categories when applying for the CRPF Constable GD recruitment. The category-wise CRPF Constable GD age limit relaxation will be as follows.

CRPF Constable Age Relaxation	
Category	CRPF Constable GD Age Limit Relaxation
Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe	5 years

Other Backward Class Category	3 years
Candidates of the first batch of Ex Agniveers	5 years
Candidates of Ex Agniveers	3 years

## **CRPF Constable GD Eligibility Criteria**

The Central Reserve Police Force specifies the CRPF Constable GD Eligibility Criteria in the official notification. The CRPF Constable Eligibility Criteria comprises elements like educational qualification, number of attempts, physical standard test, and much more. Failing to fulfill any of the CRPF GD Constable Eligibility criteria will lead to the rejection of their applications at any stage of the recruitment process.

## **CRPF Constable GD Educational Qualification**

Educational Qualification is an important factor of the CRPF Constable GD eligibility criteria for. Aspirants should have specific qualifications to be eligible for the Constable GD post in CRPF. Check the detailed CRPF Constable GD Educational Qualification shared below.

- Matric or equivalent from any recognized board or university or equivalent Army qualification in case of Ex-Army personnel.
- CRPF Constable GD Physical Standard Test and Medical Standard for recruitment to the Constable (General Duty) post in the Central Reserve Police Force shall be applicable as per the Scheme specified by the Central Government from time to time.
- Ex-Agniveers shall be exempted from the CRPF Constable GD Physical Efficiency Test (PET).

## **CRPF Constable GD Nationality**

A candidate must be a citizen of India when applying for the CRPF Constable GD recruitment process.

## **CRPF Constable GD Number of Attempts**

There are no restrictions on the number of times a candidate wants to apply for the CRPF Constable recruitment. As per CRPF Constable GD Eligibility Criteria, all the

interested aspirants can appear in this recruitment drive till they fulfil the CRPF Constable GD age limit, qualification, etc.

## **CRPF Constable GD Eligibility Criteria Disqualification Rules**

Apart from fulfilling all the CRPF Constable GD Eligibility Criteria, aspirants must also be familiar with the disqualification rules before applying for the CRPF Constable (General Duty) recruitment.

- No candidate who has entered into or contracted a marriage with an individual having a spouse living is eligible for the post.
- No candidate who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any individual is eligible for the post.
- No candidate who is not a citizen of India shall, except with the prior permission of the Central Government in writing, be eligible for the post.

**Note:** Provided that the Central Government may, if fulfilled, that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such individual and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any candidate from the execution of this rule.

## **CRPF Constable GD Eligibility Criteria Miscellaneous**

Along with the CRPF Constable GD Eligibility Criteria, aspirants must keep in mind certain points when applying for the CRPF Constable (General Duty) recruitment. Some of the important points are as follows.

- 10% vacancies shall be reserved for Ex-Agniveers for the recruitment of Constable (General Duty) posts.
- Candidates who want to avail of reservation benefits must submit the caste certificate and other documents as and when asked by the recruitment authority.
